2017 EIGHT BARREL SYRAH

The legacy of the Eight Barrel Syrah began back in 1993, with our past winemaker Daniel Gehrs. It has since evolved into one of our most sought after wines, offering a more hedonistic option to our Syrah offerings.

The aromatics of the 2017 Eight Barrel Syrah are lifted by tones of juicy plum and caramelized cinnamon, followed by an underlying element of seasoned firewood. The burly personality of this wine is evident upon the first sip, broadly covering the palate and offering an abundance of both red and blue fruits. The texture evolves as opulent tannins settle into a persistent finish of cured meats and dried cranberry
