The 2016 Toyon is a dynamic blend of Rhône and Bordeaux varietals. Aromas of blackberry, graphite, and black olive fill the glass, enticing you to take a sip. The supple tannins are carried through to the finish with flavors of tart black fruits and dark chocolate cocoa nibs.
