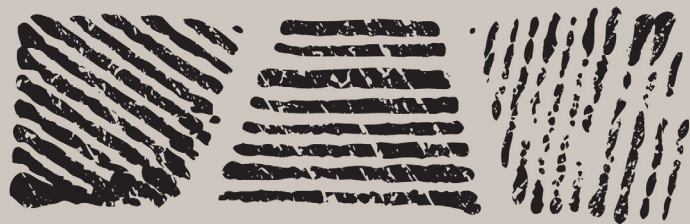

TASTING NOTES

The lively, fruity aspects of the 2021 Santa Barbara County Pinot Noir wine are balanced with earthy tones of freshly turned earth and terracotta. A wonderfully striking acidity dances across the palate with each sip and is given structure with ultra-fine tannins. A splash of fresh strawberry and cardamom on the back of the palate give the wine a lovely, spiced fruit quality.
